

Installation Tips

Because this bath is installed touching 2 walls, it may take several attempts to get the feet at the right length to enable the bath to be square in your room.

REMEMBER : most bathroom floors have some slope and many vertical walls are never square.

Thus the feet need to be adjusted to help with the installation

HOW TO.

Flip the bath over onto a protected surface and make sure the four outer feet (Fig. A) are level & slightly protruding past the outer skirt. These 4 feet take the weight

The two inner (Fig. C) feet on 1700mm Models, should be set slightly higher than the other 4 feet (not as close to the floor). These are designed to take the weight when someone steps into the bath.

Caulking then must be done on all sides that touch a wall

SYMMETRY BATH INSTALLATION

Make sure the four outer feet are level & slightly protruding past the outer skirt.

1700mm Model Shown

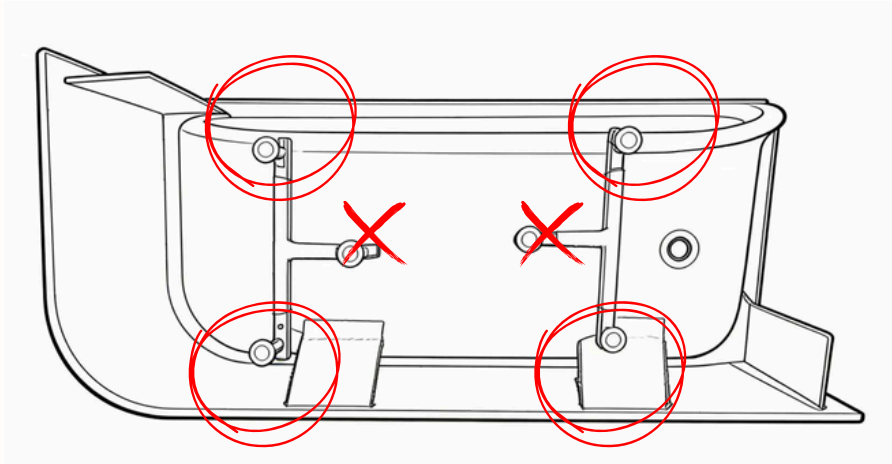

Make sure the four outer feet are level with each other

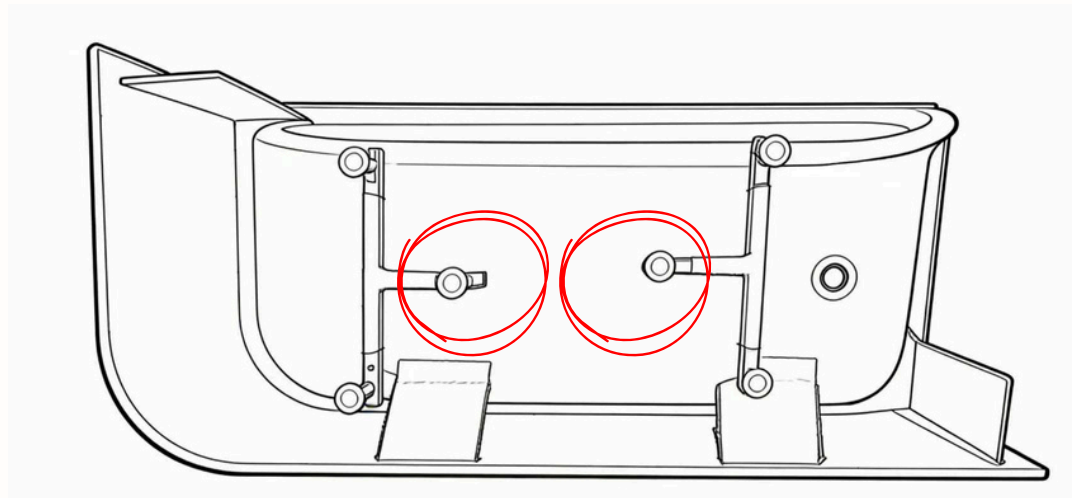
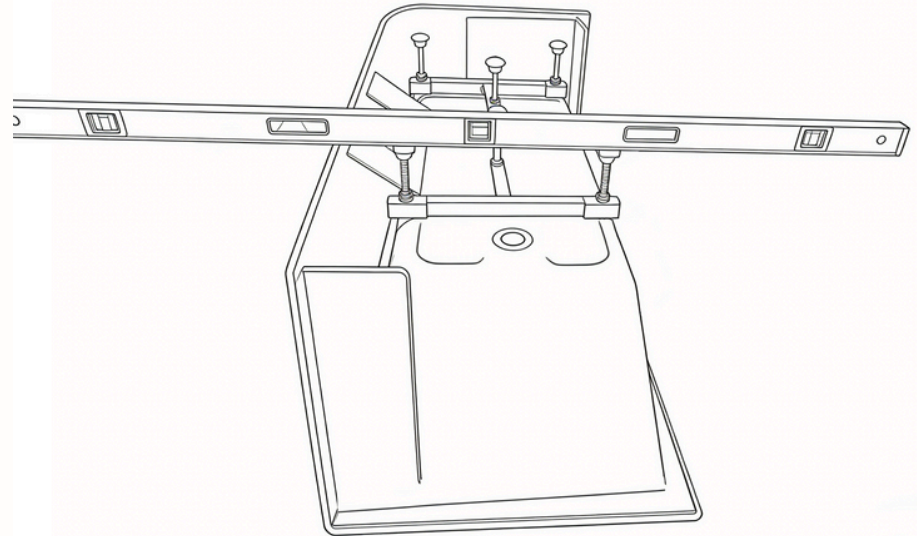


Fig C

The two inner feet (on 1700mm Models) should be set slightly higher than the other 4 feet, (not as close to the floor)
